**NOTE:**

- ◆ All fees are in Canadian funds, effective January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017.
- ◆ Exchange Rate Policy: wire transfers, money orders, cheques or cash received by Bond International College in US dollars is converted into CAD at the exchange rate determined by BIC on the day the money is received.
- ◆ A Letter of Acceptance is only issued after the tuition fees have been paid in full.
- ◆ All fees except Application Fee are refundable only if the student's application for Study Permit is refused by the Canadian Immigration authorities.
- ◆ Proof of insurance is required for all of our students while studying at Bond. While the school is not the insurer, the school has arranged for an insurance provider to insure our students studying at Bond in Canada. Bond students are required to buy the Canadian insurance recommended by Bond.
- ◆ Cost of text books varies according to courses taken. Cost of uniforms varies according to uniform items selected.
- ◆ Custodianship Legal fee is a one time legal fee to arrange custodianship in Canada for non-residence students.

## INTERNATIONAL STUDENT Secondary Fee Schedule 2017

- ◆ Custodian Deposit is refundable only if the student either reaches the age of 18 or provides the school with a new custodian.
- ◆ Custodian Deposit is not refundable if the student checks out of the residence without reaching the age of 18, and does not provide the school with a new custodian.
- ◆ Custodianship Fee is a monthly fee to act as custodian until the student reaches the age of 18 or the parent arranges for another custodian (Proof of alternative custodianship is required).
- ◆ Custodianship arranged through the school ceases when the student is no longer attending Bond or reaches the legal age.
- ◆ Once the student has been granted a Study Permit, the student is expected to arrive at the first available admission date. A new Letter of Acceptance can only be granted for that date.
- ◆ Residence fees must be paid in full at least one month before arriving. Failure to submit fees on time may result in forfeiture of the place in residence. Residence fees cannot be deferred.
- ◆ For refund, students should submit the following documents:
  - Original letter of rejection from the Canadian Embassy or Consulate
  - Original letter from the student/parent of the student requesting the refund. A letter from an agent or other representative without the original letter from the student/parents is not acceptable.
  - Original Letter of Acceptance and Official Receipt from Bond International College.
- ◆ Fees are subject to change without further notice.

### STUDENT ACCOMMODATION AT BOND INTERNATIONAL COLLEGE

Bond International College believes in an integrated approach to a student's educational experience while studying in Toronto. When parents make the important decision to enroll their sons or daughters at Bond, we believe that assistance in arranging the most appropriate accommodation is one of the most important services that we can provide.

International students have three options for accommodation at Bond:

#### **Student Residence**

Bond International College has a student residence located within a ten minute bus ride from the school.

Features of the residence include:

- 24/7 residence supervision
- furnished shared rooms
- 19 meals per week
- custodianship legal fee
- custodian fee
- wireless internet, phone, cable TV
- shuttle service to and from school
- open during school holidays

#### **Important Note:**

There are specific arrival and departure dates for students in residence. Early admission to the residence and late departure is subject to availability. Students are required to abide by the Policy and Procedures for their choice of accommodation as defined in the Residence Student Manual.

#### **Home-stay**

A Home-stay Coordinator is available to students who need assistance in finding a Canadian family for their home-stay. Special requirements such as transportation or other special needs can be arranged through the Home-stay Coordinator. Additional charges may apply.

Home-stay features vary according to each home:

- English speaking family
- Furnished private room
- Three meals a day
- Internet access
- Telephone (Local calls only)
- Laundry Facilities

#### **Private Arrangement**

Some families have friends or relatives in Toronto and can arrange for students to stay with them.

Bond International College cannot assume the responsibility of supervision or guardianship under these circumstances.
